

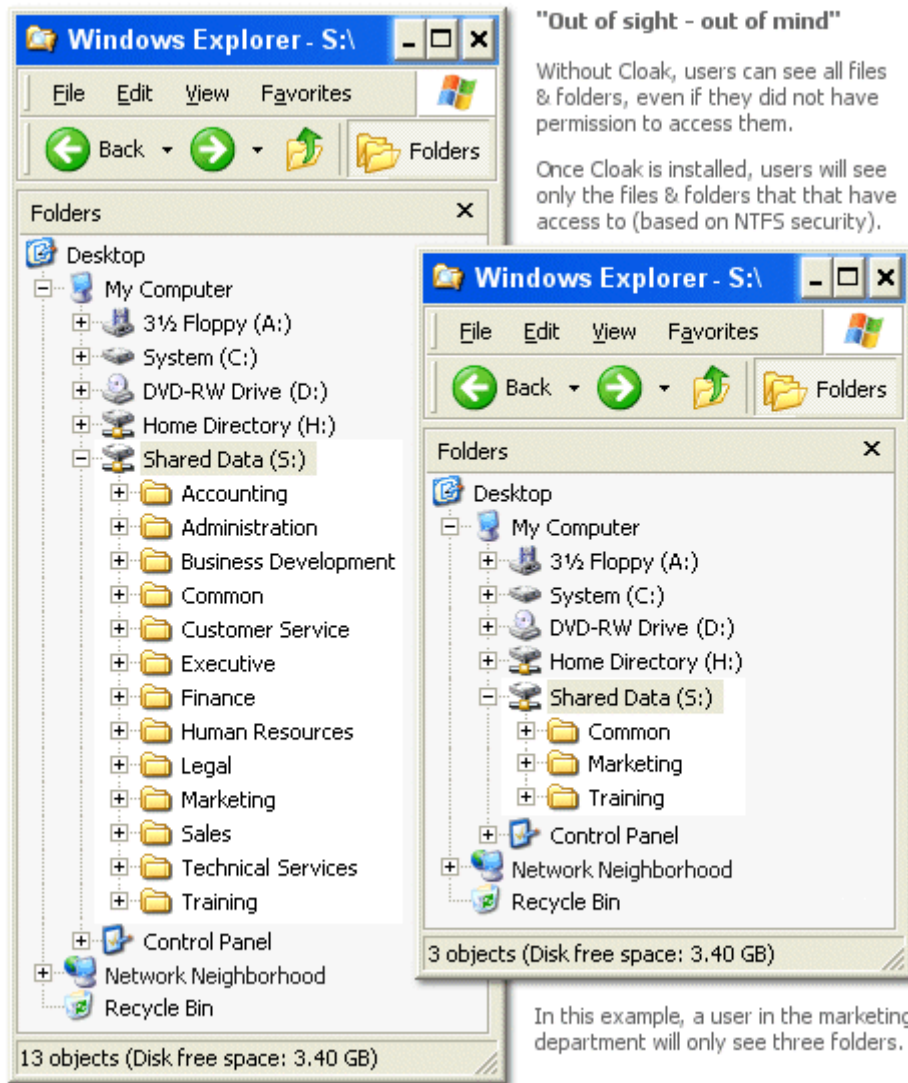
Announcing ScriptLogic Cloak™ 1.0

Designed for the security-conscious administrator, Cloak fills the void between NTFS file systems and Windows' browser-based approach to accessing them.

Less Is Better

Simply put, Cloak provides increased security on NTFS volumes by adding “Out of sight – out of mind” filtering to the Windows file system. Once Cloak is installed on your Windows Servers, users will only see the files and/or folders that they have permission to access.

Streamlined Environment for Users

In addition to tightening security, Cloak also helps to streamline your users' overall experience. Since users won't see folders and/or files that they can't access, their directory trees are measurably less cluttered. They'll receive less "Access Denied" messages because they can't click on folders that are hidden from their view (whether their attempt was intentional or accidental).

More Accurate Audits

If you have enabled File System Auditing, Cloak will also help by virtually eliminating any 'false positives' in your security event logs. Now when you review event logs and see "Object Access - Failure" entries, you can actually pay attention since the "I clicked on that folder by accident" excuses will no longer be accepted.

Upgrading to ScriptLogic Cloak version 1.0!

Upgrading to the release version of ScriptLogic Cloak from the Beta or Release Candidate version is simple. Follow the steps below that pertain to your environment and you will be up and running in no time.

Upgrading from ScriptLogic Cloak Beta versions:

Before running the installation all Beta versions of Cloak must be uninstalled. Cloak can be removed by selecting it from the *Add or Remove Programs* Control Panel applet. After the Cloak beta version is removed, the server **must** be restarted.

Once all Beta versions of Cloak are removed and the server is restarted, run the installation program to install Cloak 1.0. Following the installation, the server must be restarted.

The first time Cloak is executed, following the installation and reboot, the Cloak licensing dialog will appear. The License File should be entered if the product has been purchased. Evaluation users should leave this box blank and click **Begin Evaluation**.

Once the Registration/Evaluation process is complete, the Cloak Manager will load.

Upgrading from ScriptLogic Cloak Release Candidate versions:

Cloak Release Candidate versions can be upgraded by running the Cloak 1.0 installation. Following the installation, the server must be restarted.

The first time Cloak is executed, following the installation and reboot, the Cloak licensing dialog will appear. The License File should be entered if the product has been purchased. Evaluation users should leave this box blank.

Once the Registration/Evaluation process is complete, the Cloak Manager will load.
